



## Captain Voting Process

Every year Captains will be voted on by their teams. This can be a new captain (If a vacant space or challenging an incumbent) or an Incumbent being reconfirmed into the post.

### Process

<p>1. Nomination Process</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. At the end of each season, captains will let the Club President know if they wish to stand again for another season.</li> <li>2. Captains will let their team know that they are intending to stand or step down.</li> <li>3. At the same time, players wishing to challenge a sitting captain or fill a vacant spot need to let the Club President know if they wish to put their name forward. This can be another player nominating another player also</li> <li>4. Should another player nominate another player, the club president will speak to that player to see if that player is willing to accept the nomination.</li> <li>5. All nominations must be submitted before the proposed survey date. A deadline will be given by the Club President.</li> </ol>
<p>2. Voting Process Unopposed</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Once nominees are finalised their names will be entered into the voting section of the survey.</li> <li>2. If a player (Or players running together under one nomination) are running unopposed, the vote will be reflected as a seconding nomination.</li> <li>3. 1 vote is needed for confirmation as captain.</li> </ol>
<p>3. Voting process Opposed</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If more than one player is running for 1 position then all the names will be entered into the voting section of the survey.</li> <li>2. Teams vote for their player of choice to be captain.</li> <li>3. To secure the role player needs the following number of votes.</li> <li>4. If the vote is contested between 2 nominees then a nominee only requires a simple majority to secure the vote.</li> <li>5. If the vote is contested by 3 or more nominees, a nominee requires at least 50% of the vote to secure the vote.</li> <li>6. After the first round, if no one has secured at least 50% of the vote, then the nominees with the fewest vote will drop from the race and a runoff will take place between the two remaining candidates.</li> <li>7. A simple majority is then needed between the 2 remaining nominees.</li> </ol>
